This is an exciting opportunity as it features an ex student from the Outwood family of schools, who will be performing in the play as part of their showcase on the BA Acting: Musical Theatre course at the Central School of Speech and Drama.

AD 60. Britain is the latest conquest of the sprawling Roman Empire. Queen Boudica intends to rise up against the foreign power, but the native tribes are at each other's throats. Can a fragile coalition of warlords hang together long enough to beat back the power of Rome? And what will be lost if they can't? Premiered at the Globe in 2017, Tristan Bernays reimagines the Shakespeare history play for the age of the addictive box set. This female-driven epic narrative of scope and spectacle asks who lives on this cold island on the edge of the European continent, and who they could become.

The students are currently working on their first examined unit which comprises of the exploration of three extracts from three plays; the first being from a Shakespearean tragedy. Although it is not compulsory to attend, we strongly encourage the students to make the most of this opportunity.

There is no cost for this trip. Students will be collected from the Post 16 Centre at approximately 12.30 pm and will return to the Centre for approximately 6.30pm.
